Have your fingerprints completed ASAP. We cannot begin the long process of onboarding you without first having a cleared fingerprint check.

You may obtain "courtesy" fingerprints at any VA Hospital

- A U.S Passport or U.S. Passport Card
- A Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt Card (Form I-551)
- A foreign passport
- An Employment Authorization Document that contains a photograph (Form I-766)
- A Driver's license or an ID card issued by a State or possession of the United States provided it contains a photograph
- A U.S. Military card
- A U.S. Military dependent's ID card
- A PIV Card

Naturalized Citizen: must bring your United States Passport or a certificate of U.S. Citizenship (Form N-560 or N-561) with picture.
