- 1. I am signing this Notice because as of the date noted below, I have not received the most current COVID-19 vaccine recommended by the CDC.
- 2. I agree to follow all COVID-19 requirements (as defined by the CDPH and/or clinical site policy) of the clinical sites where I am placed related to or associated with my COVID-19 vaccination status noted above. I understand that this may include (a) wearing a mask at all times while at the clinical site and (b) purchasing additional screening or equipment the costs of which will be at my own expense.
- 3. If I seek placement at a clinical site that does not require the most current COVID-19 vaccine recommended by the CDC, I must submit a request and any required documentation to the Clinical Placement Team when I enter the Program. My request will be processed in the order of when completed requests are received.
- 4. Although the Program will attempt to place me at a clinical site that does not require the most current COVID-19 vaccine recommended by the CDC, it cannot guarantee me an alternative placement.



- 5. My failure to timely complete all Program requirements may impact my ability to complete a clinical assignment and/or delay my progression in the Program.
- 6. If there is no clinical site available, then I may not be able to fulfill the clinical requirements of the Program, which may delay my graduation and/or lead to my removal from the Program due to my failure to complete the requirements for graduation.
- 7. If I receive the most current COVID-19 vaccine recommended by the CDC, I will inform the Program as this may increase the likelihood of a successful placement at a clinical site.
